INTERNATIONAL FORD RETRACTABLE CLUB

JUDGING / SHOW FIELD RULES

1. International Ford Retractable Club (I.F.R.C.) provides judging, at no extra cost, to the members during the National Convention. A restoration guide and judging sheets are available to assist members in restoring their retractable.

2. Judging services are provided by teams of volunteers who are managed by the I.F.R.C. Chief Judge. The cars are judged on authenticity, functionality of systems, cleanliness, and workmanship.

3. The results of judging are in no way indicative of a retractable's value. Actual value of any retractable is determined when a willing seller and willing buyer arrive at a price for the retractable.

4. During judging of an owner's retractable, the owner may not ask questions of the judge or debate issues with the judges. The owner may if approached by the judges answer their questions.

5. After judging any owner may discuss with the Chief Judge any concerns they may have. The Chief Judge is the final arbiter on any disputes and the Chief Judge's decision is final.

6. Any retractable owner who causes or participates in a disruption in the judging process or on the show field will be disqualified from the judging process. This disqualification is within the sole purview of the Chief Judge.

7. The show field is under control of the Chief Judge or his designee. No For Sale signs or similar material is allowed on the show field. Display class entries are expected to follow good showmanship and show field etiquette. Any disturbance or improper behavior on the show field may result in dismissal of the offending person(s) and their retractable(s) from the show field.
